The 2nd Edition of Elissa / Didon award, on April 5th, 2016, honored 2 women from the Mediterranean at the European Parliament in Brussels.

Despite the difficult situation in the Middle East and Europe, the International Association to Save Tyre (AIST) decided to maintain the Ceremony of Elissa / Didon Award, under the auspices of the President of the European Parliament, Mr. Martin Schultz, at the European Parliament in Brussels. Mr. Schultz attended the Ceremony and gave the Awards to Mrs. Téofila Martinez, former Mayor of Cadiz in Spain for her outstanding work in favor of the Phoenician culture and heritage in the city; and Mrs. Khadijah El Salami, a Yemeni filmmaker who fights to help the youth against the grip of violence in the Arab world.

The Elissa / Didon Award annually honors two women from North and South of the Mediterranean basin, making a link between the two shores of the "Phoenician Sea". This Award honors women leaders working to strengthen equal opportunities and also the affirmation of the role of women in the cultural, political, social, economic and scientific fields.
